### **UNACCEPTABLE DONATIONS**

*Goodwill regrets that we cannot accept certain donations. The following items are either too costly to handle, repair or sell. We appreciate your understanding and value your support as a donor. For information on recycling some of the items below search your county waste management website.*

1. Large appliance (refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters)
2. Automobile doors, fenders, motors, tires, wheels, hubcaps, etc.
3. Household trash and garbage, hazardous/poisonous materials
4. TV's (except Flat Screens)
5. Building and plumbing materials: windows, doors, sinks, tubs
6. Excessively large/bulky items: swing sets, swimming pools, carpeting, metal and office desks
7. Furniture that is covered in animal hair, broken, worn, torn, stained, missing parts, and sleeper sofas
8. Mattresses
9. Foodstuffs of any kind
10. Household chemicals, insecticides, cleaning products and cans of paint
11. Propane, helium or oxygen tanks and kerosene heaters
12. Weapons: guns, hunting knives, ammunition, fireworks, artillery shells or any potentially explosive device
13. Cribs, car seats, walkers, high chairs or other products that do not meet the current safety products standards of the U.S. Consumer Products Safety Commission
14. Trophies
15. Pianos (upright or grand); organs
16. Billiard/pool tables
17. Medical supplies: syringes, lancets, diabetic supplies or prescription medication
18. Medical waste.
19. Liquids of any description
20. Alcohol
