Your Goodwill President & CEO is Anne Richards, a northeast Ohio native who works out of the Canton office. No CEO in the Goodwill system has ever made millions of dollars as an annual salary. Ever.

MYTH:

All the good items at Goodwill stores are sold first to its own employees.

FACT:

Goodwill has a strict policy against employees purchasing items before they reach the sales floor. There is a waiting period before items can be purchased. Violation of this policy may result in termination.
