- ✓ **Miscellaneous** *bicycles, jewelry, Christmas trees, Halloween costumes, drum sets, lawn tools, medical aids, walkers, free weights, pinball machines, game table, games, power tools, table saw, etc., garden tools, golf clubs, sporting goods, grills (charcoal only), toys, hand tools, wheelchair and scooters (with working battery).*
